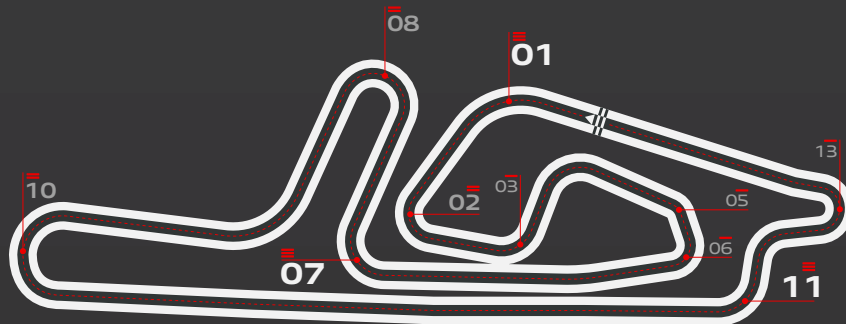

## CREMONA CIRCUIT

Superbike World Championship debuted last year in Cremona, on a circuit inaugurated in 2011 but already modified on a couple of occasions: the first time in 2021 and a second time in 2024, when the entire track was resurfaced.

The average lap speed is 154 km/h (96 mph), the lowest of the championship, but top speeds reach 308 km/h (191 mph).
